

GUIDE TO COMPLETING THE STUDENT VISA EXTENSION ONLINE APPLICATION

Applying from *inside* the UK Using the IDV App

Before beginning your visa application, you must ensure that you read the Home Office's <u>Student Visa Guidance</u>

This screenshot guide explains the process of completing the Student visa online application applying from **inside** the UK.

GETTING STARTED

To begin your application, setup an online account via the online link below: <u>https://www.gov.uk/student-visa/extend-your-visa</u>

Scroll down and click on the 'Start now' green button – see screenshot below:

Apply

You must apply online.

As part of your application you'll need to prove your identity. How you do this depends on where you're from and the type of passport or resident permit you have.

You'll either:

- use the 'UK Immigration: ID Check' app to scan your identity document you'll
 also create or sign in to your UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) account
- give your fingerprints and a photograph (biometric information) at a UK Visa and Citizenship Application Services (UKVCAS) service point - this is to get a biometric residence permit

You'll be told what you need to do when you apply.

Check the phone's settings to see if it has NFC. The phone has NFC if you can use it to make contactless payments.

If you do not have a phone

Ask a friend or family member if you can use their phone. No information is stored on the app or phone after you close it.

You do not have to apply on the phone - you can do the rest of your application on your computer or another device.

We will send your decision letter by email – this can be your email or someone else's. You do not use your decision letter to prove your status.

If you have a smart phone that supports contactless payment, click **continue**. Information about the IDV app can be accessed <u>here</u>

If not, click on the option below the **continue**' box '**I do not have a phone that can use the app**' and you will be directed to the online application form where a biometric appointment will be required.



This is usually the document you used when you created your account. If you have added a new document to your account, use the most recent document to sign in.

Select the document you used to create an account when you signed up for eVisa.



After signing in successfully, you should see a Student visa application appeared under 'Your forms'. now click on 'Start application'

Click on the **'Confirm your** identity' link to begin.

Click 'Continue' to see if you can use the IDV to complete the visa application.

This is the same process you went through when you created an account for eVisa.

Using the app

The quickest way to confirm your identity is on the 'UK Immigration: ID check app.

The next questions will find out how you can confirm your identity.

To use the app, you will need:

- your identity document
- an iPhone 7 or newer, or an Android phone that can make contactless payments

You can use someone else's phone if you need to. The app can be deleted once your identity has been confirmed.

Going to a visa centre

If you cannot use the app, you may need to have your fingerprints and photo taken at a visa centre.

If you need to do this, you will be able to book your appointment later.

Once the connection has been established, you will need to complete the followings on the IDV app:

- Verify your phone number
- scan or take a photo of your passport
- Scan your face
- Take a photo of yourself
- Submit your details

Once 'confirm your identity' part of the application is done, you can start completing your personal and immigration history details.

Select 'No' if you have not received any medical treatment in the UK.

If you select 'Yes', you will have to give more details and confirm whether you needed to pay for this service or not.

Enter your National Insurance Number (NI number) or confirm that you don't have one.

If you have any other outstanding visa application at the UKVI, select 'Yes' then give the application reference number.

Most students will answer this as 'No'.

The next set of questions will ask you to confirm if you have previously had any immigration related problems for the UK or any other countries. You must read and answer each question accurately declaring all immigration related problems as any false information may jeopardise your visa application.



If you select 'Yes' to these questions, you will have to give details of any immigration problems or breach of the UK immigration law.

It is very important to declare any immigration problems or breaches otherwise your visa application may get refused, and you would be required to leave the UK.



Read and select as appropriate, then click 'Continue'.

Important: the next set of questions refer to any criminal convictions, penalties, war or terror related crimes or activities. Again, you must read and answer each question accurately and truthfully as any false information provided may jeopardise your visa application.

The university will issue you a new CAS, as you cannot submit a Student visa application without it. Please **pause at this question** in your application. You will complete the remaining sections during your visa submission appointment, or once you have received your new CAS.
